Summary This is a hands-on introductory course to implant retained dentures. We will review the principles behind different kinds of implant abutments and housing systems related to removable implant dentures. We will use the Noxalas Housing system, a "Locator-like" housing and abutment system that utilizes PEEK liners instead of soft nylon liners, as our hands-on material. We will also discuss the pros and cons of each system. The goal of this course is to show the audience the principles of implant retained removable dentures and the many options out there that are best suited for their patients.
